**BASIC FUNCTION**

The Software Engineer is responsible for the design of business and student information systems. This position is charged with the design, development and documentation of computer programs and interfaces used in the delivery of these systems. Except during periods of illness and personal leave the individual is on call and responds to problems 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

**REPRESENTATIVE DUTIES:**

Designs, develops and maintains databases and software applications.

Design and maintenance of district Web sites. Establish Web publishing guidelines and tools.

Applies independent judgment, discretion, and analysis in coordinating the implementation and maintenance of information systems for business and student information needs.

Defines and develops practical information system documentation utilizing pseudo-code, flowcharts, block diagrams, process charts, and layouts for solutions to business and student information system needs.

Establishes and publishes new programming techniques, methods, procedures, and standards working with basic and advanced applications system design techniques and methodologies.

Communicates and coordinates with users during the various phases of testing and implementation.

Maintains awareness of state-of-the-art development tools, programming techniques, problem solving techniques and computing equipment.

Participates in end user consulting including defining system requirements, detailed system design and development of software and database solutions.

Establishes programming techniques and procedures for working within the District's hardware and software architectures.

Oversees all aspects of end user consulting, systems analysis, general systems design, and detail systems design.

Learns user functions, organization and role in the District to the extent required.

Provides input to and review of NIS technology policies as they relate to issues of data architecture and data security.

Assists in the resolution of application and system software problems impacting client server, production systems, and networks, as required.

Informs senior management of potential problems before they occur and communicates possible solutions.

Fulfills departmental requirements in terms of providing work coverage hours and administrative notification during periods of personal illness, vacation or education.

Assists in the hiring and review of NIS staff as requested.

Performs all responsibilities within the guidelines of district policies, regulations, and procedures.

Performs other related duties as assigned.
